- 4) Time Summary verifying a minimum of 30 hours devoted to this project

For Three Credits:

- 1) Assignment Overview
- 2) 8- to 10-page outline or written presentation of the project.
- 3) List of materials, texts, equipment, etc. used to formulate and/or become part of the project
- 4) 2- to 3-page summary of the results of the project after implementation
- 5) Time Summary verifying a minimum of 45 hours devoted to this project

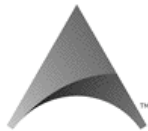
For Four Credits:

- 1) Assignment Overview
- 2) 12- to 14-page outline or written presentation of the project.
- 3) List of materials, texts, equipment, etc. used to formulate and/or become part of the project
- 4) 4- to 6-page summary of the results of the project after implementation
- 5) Time Summary verifying a minimum of 60 hours devoted to this project

(Do This Assignment First)

- 4) What audience will be receiving this information and what methods will be used to disseminate the information to them?

- 5) What measure of effectiveness, if any, will you use to evaluate the effectiveness of your presentation?

- 6) When do you plan to use or present the project you have developed and how much time do you feel will be adequate to complete your presentation?

- 7) Any additional comments or project-related points you wish to make?

A reminder - These are open-ended questions that are meant to initiate and/or stimulate the formation of your ultimate project, classroom unit of study, or other instructional experience for which you are developing this credit.
